

And I think there is one big learning after all the pain life has caused me so far: If we have a support system, a shoulder we can lean on, someone we can call when we don't know how to handle it, that's the most important thing.

So welcoming you all to Bad Ragaz for our $8^{\rm th}$ League of Leading Ladies Conference means the world to me. Because my soul tribe gathers together again.







Having worked for major players such as L'Oreal, Lelo Group, Cutler and Gross and O Boticário, Dominnique's career highlight to date is being a UN Delegate at UN Women. A truly humbling time to understand the fabric of our global pain points echoed in each country's sociopolitical system - then meet, talk and be inspired by those making a change for all of our futures.

Dominnique is passionate about empowering women of all ages to understand more about sex, taxes and money, alongside creating good and smart businesses to contribute what she can in creating a better world through behavioral change. Hustle... that is the culture our society is built on. Busy at all times. With texts, emails, phone calls, socials, social gatherings, putting your best foot forward. Busy... Days that turn into blurs, weekends filled with chores and trying to catch up on rest, only to be surprised yet again when Sunday evening rolls around and you haven't been able to fully breathe just yet. Trying to be a good mother, father, parent, sister, friend and yet unable to juggle everything effectively and instead, it causes you more stress rather than enjoyment. Overwhelm and anxiety creep in as you're falling asleep, rather than enjoying a peaceful, restful night.

How did it get to this point?

We study so hard at school, climb the career ladder, find love, create a family and we should be content with living the dream. So why does society reflect a different reality, where most people are tired and unfulfilled? Where did it all go so wrong? How do you get your life back on track? And most importantly, when do we take the time to come face to face with the inevitable reality that any day could be the last day? Would you be satisfied with your life as it is now? Or would you approach your work differently?

Sorelle tackled these questions in 2022 after 14 years of deep hustling, which led to 3 years of burnout, which forced her to take a full year of semi-retirement. Sorelle was known by all her friends, family and followers as the go-getter, productive, inspiring career woman, only to lose all this capacity to even answer a single email, let alone create any meaningful work.

With her body and soul unable to physically work, she had to find ways to awaken her spirit and mind yet again. Baby steps allowed for a gradual reintroduction of work, but this time, with a twist.

In Sorelle's keynote speech, she will guide the audience through the same process she used for herself. She will identify the areas of her life that are the strongest and which areas are neglected, in order to bring balance and therefore longevity into living, preventing inevitable burnout, if there is no balance.

Furthermore, the audience will be guided through a way to identify what feels like the right ventures to pursue for them, and which ones to release, in order to maximize work time and minimize wasteful activities, which will increase long-term enjoyment and productivity.

Sorelle Amore is an Aussie entrepreneur who focuses on obtaining ultimate levels of freedom in every area of life and is an advocate for alternative and free living. Her wild journey started in 2016 as a YouTuber, showing people the possibility of creating freedom in life through embracing the concept of being a Digital Nomad. Sorelle has been featured in numerous global media outlets including Forbes, Business Insider, Cosmopolitan, Buzzfeed, Daily Telegraph, news.com.au, and many more. She has traveled to 50+ countries, now travels full time with home bases in multiple countries. Sorelle is an investor in businesses, real estate, crypto, fine art and precious metals and now is a financial educator, sharing her knowledge of entrepreneurship, investing and freedom with the world through her business Abundantia, which she co-founded.

THE BLOOMING OF THE DESERT FLOWER

Waris Dirie was born in 1965 in the Somali desert, as one of 12 children of a nomadic family from the Clan of Darod. At the age of 5, she suffered the cruel ritual of female genital mutilation (FGM). When at the age of 13 she was forced to marry a man who could have been her grandfather, she fled through the desert to Somalia's capital Mogadishu. In 1981 her uncle, who was Somali ambassador, brought her to London as a maid. When he was ordered back to Somalia, Waris fled the embassy. She lived in the streets of London, keeping her head above water as a cleaner at a fast-food chain.

At the age of 18, her life changed abruptly. By chance, she was discovered as a model by the English photographer Terence Donovan, who photographed her in 1987 with the then unknown Naomi Campbell for the Pirelli calendar. Waris achieved international fame overnight and became one of the first supermodels. In 1987, she also got a role in the James Bond film The Living Davlights. She moved from London to New York, posed for world brands like Revlon, L'Oréal, Chanel or Levi's and adorned the covers of all major magazines worldwide. She walked the catwalks of Paris, London, Milan and New York. Waris was at the height of her modelling career in 1997, when she was interviewed by a journalist, and for the first time spoke about her trauma of circumcision, triggering a worldwide media response and a wave of compassion. The then UN Secretary General Kofi Annan appointed her UN Special Envoy against Female Genital Mutilation. On behalf of the United Nations. Waris travelled around the world, met heads of state, Nobel Prize winners, Hollywood stars, and gave hundreds of interviews. Her first book Desert Flower appeared the same year, in 1997. It became a bestseller, sold over 12 million copies, was successfully filmed in 2008 and sold in over 50 countries.

The fight against female genital mutilation had become a mission for Waris. In 2002, she founded the Desert Flower Foundation in Vienna, Austria. It's a foundation that campaigns against FGM, collects donations to help those affected and builds schools in Africa.

Her story is unique, and who else could share more about post-traumatic growth than Waris Dirie?

ACCELERATING GROWTH: WHAT THE MOST RESILIENT OF US KNOW AND DO!

In times of upheaval, uncertainty and surprise, the most resilient of us invest in practices and perspectives that enable us to be agile in our responses, clear about our energy deployment, centered in our health and wellbeing while leveraging our better selves.

In this keynote presentation, Dr. Maria Sirois outlines the latest research in the fields of resilience and post-traumatic growth and provides specific tools and perspectives that build individual and team-based resilience, irrespective of the difficulty of the moment. She'll address what it means to hold a grounded optimism, how we might pivot from derailing thoughts/emotions to beneficial action, and what the most successful teams know to do in the presence of complexity. This work blends beautifully with recent understandings as well in the field of leadership development, in particular the work of Hermina Ibarra and researchers in the field of Appreciative Inquiry such as David Cooperrider, who have helped us understand how we might leverage the multiple aspects of ourselves to potentiate success in new and challenging environments.


Post-Traumatic Growth (PTG) is a process through which a traumatic or difficult event triggers new understandings in how we see ourselves, how we make sense of our world, what and who we choose to invest in and what we find meaningful. We need to shift our focus from threat to opportunity, build an internal sense of efficacy and grounded hope that both inspires and motivates us to engage the best of ourselves. Resilience is not just about getting through difficult or dangerous times – it is that and more. It also refers to a process through which we learn to center ourselves as leaders of our own lives, and from that place of personal leadership, begin to find the hidden opportunity in every stressor by shaping our thoughts, emotions and behaviors in directions that serve us.

Resilience can be taught and increased at any time.

It does require a focused attention on the habits that currently derail us, and those that actually make a positive difference. Our keynote conversation will highlight a few of the most important considerations in learning to shift our resilient capacity in healthier and wiser directions - ones that enable both wellbeing and success. Attendees will leave with a deeper understanding of resilient growth, with specific tools that can be practiced both at work and at home, and shifts in perspective that underscore our astonishing ability to rise, even in the most difficult of times.

Maria Sirois, PsyD, is a positive psychologist and seminar leader who teaches internationally in the intersection of resilience and flourishing. Known for her wisdom, authenticity, and rampant humor, she delivers invigorating practices. Maria offers a wealth of perspective from decades of study in the areas of mind-body medicine and resilience to those who seek personal transformation and an increase in meaning, happiness, and health. Maria is the author of A Short Course in Happiness After Loss (And Other Dark, Difficult Times) and Every Day Counts.

ACCELERATING GROWTH: WHAT THE MOST RESILIENT OF US KNOW AND DO!

Post-Traumatic Growth (PTG) is a process through which a traumatic or difficult event triggers new understandings in how we see ourselves, how we make sense of our world, what and who we choose to invest in and what we find meaningful. "Who might I be at my best in a moment of conflict with a leader?"

These questions, and others that shift our focus from threat to opportunity, build an internal sense of efficacy and grounded hope that both inspires and motivates us to engage the best of ourselves. It also refers to a process through which we learn to center ourselves as leaders of our own lives, and from that place of personal leadership, begin to find the hidden opportunity in every stressor by shaping our thoughts, emotions and behaviors in directions that serve us. This is the difference between a CEO who runs away from conflict, to one who faces it directly after having gathered the necessary information to make the wisest decision possible. It is the difference between an employee hoping that someone will notice her talents, to one who has the courage to ask brayely to be considered for greater responsibility because she has grown in her sense of value and has a clear idea about how she already contributes to the greater good of the enterprise. It is also the difference between a woman who feels oppressed by the demands of the organization and the demands coming at her from home, versus the woman who know how to prioritize, delegate and honor her own needs for recovery and inspiration. Resilience can be taught and increased at any time. It does require a focused attention on the habits that currently derail us, and those that actually make a positive difference. Our keynote conversation will highlight a few of the most important considerations in learning to shift our resilient capacity in healthier and wiser directions - ones that enable both wellbeing and success. Attendees will leave with a deeper understanding of resilient growth, with specific tools that can be practiced both at work and at home, and shifts in perspective that underscore our astonishing ability to rise, even in the most difficult of times.
